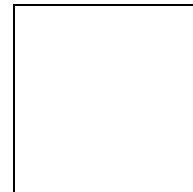

Who We Are

Mountain Ministries was started in 1999 by Gary and Fay Miller as an outreach to people on drugs.

Our goal is to restore lives that are being destroyed by alcohol and drug addictions. This transformation will begin with the establishment of a healthy relationship with Jesus Christ and then with society at large. We believe that only as a person is set free of their destructive addictions can they break negative habits and relationships. This work is accomplished in cooperation with the power of God and is an ongoing process. We expect that after a year at the Mountain Ministries Ranch, residents will be able to return to society as productive, healthy citizens.

All our staff at Mountain Ministries work on a volunteer basis. None of our budget is paid in wages. Typically the cost of a live-in drug and alcohol program is quite high. We believe God to provide finances to not only house those that come to us, but to empower them through Jesus Christ to have a new addiction free life. We accept people that have no way to pay for the cost of most programs. Cost to operate comes from people like you who believe in what God is doing here.

What We Do

Mountain Ministries Ranch follows strict guidelines and applies Christian principles that teach people to live responsible lives. The majority of the people we help have struggled with drugs and alcohol.

Healing begins when someone realizes that they need God and that they can have a true and wonderful purpose in life. This is what we are all about. This is a one year residential treatment program for men and men with children, designed to give them the opportunity to:

- Learn Parenting Skills
- Building Healthy Relationships
- Learn how to Rely on the Lord

Testimonies

I came from a physically and emotionally abusive home. I was introduced to alcohol and cigarettes at the tender age of four. My performance in school was poor due to skipping classes and drinking, and I got in trouble with the law in my Junior High years. I entered the Service at the age of 17 where I continued to drink and smoke pot.

My drinking resulted in a DUI which I ran away from the charges to another state which eventually caught up with me and I was extradited to serve time. After I was released I moved back to Washington State. 1987 through 1996 is remembered as kind of a blur of drinking, outpatient treatment, and working random temporary jobs.

Over the years, I gained knowledge on everything one could know about Alcoholics Anonymous. I attended 12 different treatment centers, yet I continued to drink. When going to the outpatient sessions, I would have a bottle in my backpack and drink between meetings.

My wife died in 2006 which set me off on drinking binges. I ended up homeless and lost everything, family, friends, possessions and almost my life. I was found under a bridge and sent to a detoxification unit where I found out about Mountain Ministries Ranch. I had wanted to go to a long term program as the numerous 30 day programs I had been to were unsuccessful.

Mountain Ministries has shown me that I am a person of worth and value. I don't need to depend on alcohol or drugs to cover the pain of life. I have learned to rely on the Lord for my strength, peace and joy. I now have a purpose in life. "Looking back to 15 years ago, I would have never imagined myself alive today. The past is the past. I walk free now." **"So be on your guard, not asleep like others. Stay alert and be Sober"**
